GIBSIDE SCHOOL FOR CHILDREN WITH SPECIAL EDUCATIONAL NEEDS



Gibside is Gateshead's Primary school for children with special educational needs. It provides an education for around 120 pupils with a range of needs including Profound Multiple Learning Difficulties, Severe Learning Difficulties and Autism. We have a split site with Early Years based at Blaydon and Years 1 to 6 at Whickham.

Gibside aims to provide an environment and experiences that motivate and inspire their pupils to achieve their personal best and develop high self-esteem.

Our aim is to raise funds for a 'CTouch' Interactive Display Board – the latest generation of interactive large format displays. The multi-touch surface increases engagement, involvement and collaboration, ideal for Gibside's requirements

HARLEY STALLARD'S PHSYIOTHERAPY ROOM



This special young man is Harley Stallard who lives in Washington with parents Claire and Shaun, and his Sister Kia. Harley was born 3 months prematurely and on his second day of life suffered a bleed on the brain that left him with Cerebral Palsy

Harley has to be tube fed as he is not able to chew properly, but despite these challenges he continues to be a happy young lad, taking everything as it comes.

Harley's healthcare professionals have recommended a hydrotherapy pool to aid Harley's physiotherapy at home, unfortunately due to the size of their home, the pool will need to be housed outside.

Our aim is to raise funds for an outer house to be built to accommodate Harley's physiotherapy equipment, including a hydrotherapy pool that was generously donated by the Sunshine Fund.
